# Pitches on the Keyboard

*ANSWER KEY*

For each arrow pointing to the keyboard, notate the pitches on the grand staff below. For the black keys, notate both possible enharmonic pitches. For the white keys, don't worry about enharmonics (unless you want to!) Remember where Middle C is on the keyboard and on the treble and bass clefs.
