
Writing Major Scale Degrees

ANSWER KEY

With the given major key and scale degree, write the corresponding note. Until these are memorized, build a major scale and just count up to determine the right note ... and to make sure you have the right accidental. Remember to start counting from the first note of the major scale (i.e., the first note is the 1st scale degree.) Check the clef. Choose whichever octave you like!
