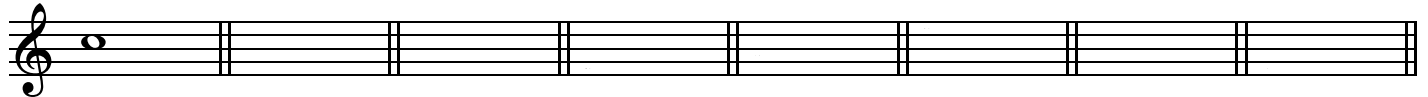

Writing Major Scale Degrees

G: $\hat{3}$

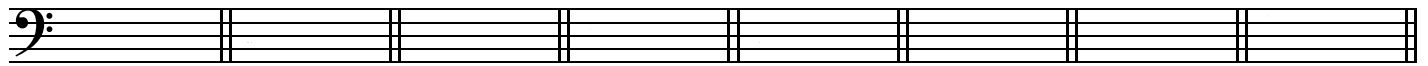
