Writing Major Scales Using Whole and Half Steps

PRACTICE DRILL

Using the pattern **WWHWWWH** (**W** = Whole Step, **H** = Half Step), build all the major scales. Some scales (like A major) could be in either octave. Take your pick! Remember to go from note name to note name, not skipping any of them (i.e., don't do this: C D **Fb** F G A B C :) Accidentals go directly to the left of each notehead. Finally, pay attention to which clef you're in. Enjoy building those scale muscles!
