
Writing Natural Minor Scale Degrees

ANSWER KEY

With the given natural minor key and scale degree, write the corresponding note. Until these are memorized, build a natural minor scale and just count up to determine the right note and accidental. Remember to start counting from the first note of the minor scale (i.e., the first note is the 1st scale degree.) Check the clef. Choose whichever octave you like!
